

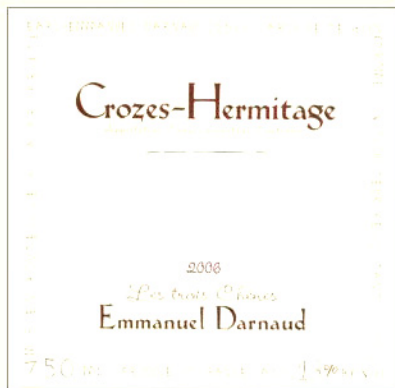

Another new estate for me, Darnaud's **2006 Crozes-Hermitage Les Trois Chênes** stood out in my tastings. It boasts a deep ruby/purple hue as well as notes of licorice, camphor, spring flowers, and black

currants, supple tannins, medium to full body, a lovely texture, beautiful concentration, and outstanding purity and length. Drink it over the next 7-8 years. No known American importer.
