

## 2014 E Darnaud St Joseph

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Another deep, inky-colored wine is the 2014 Saint Joseph, which defies the vintage stereotype—it has real depth and richness. Black raspberry, cassis, toasted spice and hints of oak all emerge from this beauty, which hits the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, a forward, supple texture and a great finish. Relatively forward and soft, it's not going to make old bones, but will nevertheless drink beautifully for 5-7 years.
