Wine Tasting :	<p>Colour : A nice crimson colour of a beautiful intensity with purple reflections</p> <p>Nose : The nose is open and expressive with a beautiful delicacy. Deep in structure, it reveals subtle roasting aromas as well as kirsch notes and a slightly smoky hint</p> <p>Palate : The palate is soft and delicate at the beginning. It then reveals a straightness and a slender character. The tannins are dense and offer a great depth. The finish is fresh and durable</p> <p>Good with : This wine requires a cuisine of taste and character. <u>Pairing examples :</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Double rib steak à la bordelaise, candied shallots, « râpée » de pomme de terre,• Squab roasted on the trunk, reduced juice, mashed sweet potatoes,• Old mimolette or truffled Brillat-Savarin
