<b>Wine tasting :</b>	<p>Color : Golden, brilliant and bright</p> <p>Nose : Subtle and elegant, revealing citrus and juicy fruit such as the white nectarine notes</p> <p>Palate : Rich and delicate tasting with a crispy final mixed with citrus aromas as lemon. A great Elegance wine</p> <p>Pairing : This wine will be perfect with strong and flavoursome dishes such as zander fish au beurre, served with chards « confites au lard ». A few cannellonis stuffed with veal and spinach, covered with plenty of Ricotta</p>
